Concerns were raised regarding antisocial behaviour around Sodens Avenue. The Parish Council will provide support in liaising with Police and Rugby Borough Council as required, however the Parish Council cannot take any action in this matter. The residents were encouraged to report any incidents to 111.

Concerns were raised regarding the closure of central reservation to Grange Farm on A45. The Parish Council has liaised with Highways England regarding this matter. The closure is due to a planning condition being placed on this development which should have appeared when solicitors carried out searches on the new properties. The closure is also due to being unable to meet safety requirements. The Parish Council do not plan to object but residents can comment should they wish to do so.
